



The following is a detailed description of the protocols we will be following at our So Fly Kids, Inc. Academy of Dance. [We will be following the LA County Gym and Fitness Establishments Protocol found here.](#) The Studio will open on August 16th for a 6 week summer session through September 26th.

Our facility has been deep cleaned (CDC certified) and will continue to be weekly. Medical Grade Filtration H13 True HEPA air purifiers have been installed throughout.

Summary of Daily Safety Practices:

- Special staff training by a registered nurse will be given to all SFK staff on covid-19 sanitization, best practices, and other safety measures.
- Drop-off and pick-up at the studio will be spaced out with social distancing markers.
- NO parents or outsiders allowed in our facility, strictly dancers and staff.
- Masks and face shields will be required by all staff, all day.
- Masks for campers and parents will be required to check-in/out and encouraged for dancers throughout class.
- Wellness screenings for dancers and staff will be taken at the start of each day/class, including touchless thermometer readings.
- A touchless hand washing station will be placed at the entrance of our facility.
- Touchless hand sanitizer will be placed throughout the facility.
- Classes will be no more than 10 dancers per class, as recommended by LA County Department of Health.
- No more than 1 staff member will be assigned to each class.
- Classes will remain constant throughout each week, and will not intermingle.
- Activities will be adjusted to have little to no contact with plenty of outside time.
- Markers will be placed on the studio floor separating students 6 feet apart
- Handwashing will take place before and after every class.
- Hospital grade disinfectant will be used on the entire facility, including before/after each activity.



Further Details of Specific Safety Practices:

We trained our staff on July 3rd, 2020 to ensure they are prepared to follow our health and safety standards. A Registered Nurse has trained our staff on how to sanitize and maintain a safe environment for our students and staff. Disposable masks, gloves, and face shields will be used and provided by So Fly Kids. If a staff member exhibits any signs/symptoms of the novel Coronavirus, they will be asked to stay home.

Before each work day, staff will have their temperature taken and fill out a wellness survey. Dancers are asked to arrive no earlier than 5 minutes prior to class, staggering out arrivals as much as possible to avoid a large gathering. Masks are required to drop off dancers and will be encouraged throughout the entire class. There are markers on the floor outside of So Fly Kids implementing a 6 feet apart rule. Dancers will have their temperature taken with a touchless thermometer and a parent or guardian will fill out a wellness survey before entry. Pens to sign-in will be sanitized after each use. No parent or outside visitors (besides our once weekly SFK approved vendor) will be allowed into our facility. There will be a portable hand washing station at the entry with a touchless hand soap dispenser. Each dancer and staff member are required to wash their hands prior to entering.

Class size will be limited. Groups will be no larger than 10 dancers to one instructor. Classes will not intermingle with one another. Activities within the classes will have little to no contact with one another. Markers will be placed in each room to visibly show social distance practices. Markers will also be in place to separate dancers' belongings e.g. shoes, water bottles, jackets.

Handwashing will be taking place before and after each class. The facility will be disinfected between every class with hospital grade cleaning spray: Vital-Oxide. Professional cleaners will be in each week to deep-clean. The HVAC double filter has been replaced, and Medical Grade Filtration H13 True HEPA air purifiers have been installed throughout to provide the best air quality as possible.

Pick-up will be done one at a time and staggered similar to drop-off. Campers will wait inside on their marker until their parent/guardian checks them out. Masks are required for pick up. Those picking up their camper must remain outside using designated signage/markers until it is their turn.
