



The following is a detailed description of the protocols we will be following at our So Fly Kids, Inc. Learning Lab and Enrichment Arts Camp. We will be following the LA County Day-Camp Protocol found [here](#) and the ACA field guide found [here](#). This program begins August 18, 2020 and will run Monday through Friday, 8:30-2:30 (Learning Lab Only) and 2:30-5:30 (Enrichment Arts Camp).

Our facility has been deep cleaned (CDC certified) and will continue weekly. Medical Grade Filtration H13 True HEPA air purifiers have been installed throughout.

SFK is proud to announce that we have a Registered Nurse that has led our staff in proper training to ensure maximum safety procedures for students and faculty.

Summary of Daily Camp Safety Practices:

- Special staff training by a registered nurse will be given to all SFK staff on covid-19 sanitization, best practices, and other safety measures.
- Drop-off and pick-up will be directly at the studio, and spaced out with social distancing markers.
- NO parents or outsiders allowed in our facility, strictly students and staff.
- Masks and face shields will be required by all staff, all day.
- Masks for students and parents will be required to check-in/out and encouraged for students throughout the day.
- Wellness screenings for students and staff will be taken at the start of each day, including touchless thermometer readings.
- A touchless hand washing station will be placed at the entrance of our facility.
- Touchless hand sanitizer will be placed throughout the facility.
- "Pods" will be separated by studio and kept socially distanced by partitions, as recommended by LA County Department of Health.
- Staff members will be assigned to each pod and kept constant to minimize contact



- Pods will not intermingle.
- Activities will be adjusted to have little to no contact.
- Materials will rarely be shared, if they *need* to be, they will be thoroughly sanitized
- Handwashing will take place before and after every activity.
- Hospital grade disinfectant will be used on the entire facility, including before/after each activity.
- Lunch and snack items will not be shared amongst students.

Further Details of Specific Safety Practices:

We began training for our staff on July 3rd, 2020 to ensure they are prepared to follow our health and safety standards. A Registered Nurse will be training our staff on how to sanitize and maintain a safe environment for our campers and staff. Disposable masks, gloves, and face shields will be used and provided by So Fly Kids. If a staff member exhibits any signs/symptoms of the novel Coronavirus, they will be asked to stay home.

Before each day, staff will have their temperature taken and fill out a wellness survey. Students are asked to arrive between 8:30am and 9:00am, staggering out arrivals as much as possible to avoid a large gathering. Masks are required to drop off students and will be encouraged though the entire day. There are markers on the floor outside of So Fly Kids implementing a 6 feet apart rule. Pens to sign-in will be sanitized after each use. Students will have their temperature taken with a touchless thermometer and a parent or guardian will fill out a wellness survey before entry. No parent or outside visitors (besides our once weekly SFK approved vendor) will be allowed into our facility There will be a portable hand washing station at the entry with a touchless hand soap dispenser. Each student and staff member are required to wash their hands prior to entering.



Attendance will be limited. Groups will remain constant throughout the day (and week for those attending multiple days) and will not intermingle with one another. Siblings/those who live together will be placed in the same group. Tables for the Learning Lab portion will be separated using a four way partition. These partitions will ensure social distancing and be sanitized regularly. Activities within the stable groups will have little to no contact with one another. Markers will be placed in each room to visibly show social distance practices. Markers will also be in place to separate campers' belongings e.g. shoes, water bottles, jackets.

Lunch and snacks will either be packed from their home or will be provided by Organic Kids LA (pending on numbers). The later will guarantee pre-packed, disposable containers and utensils that cannot be reused or shared.

Handwashing will be taking place before and after each activity. The facility will be disinfected between every activity with hospital grade cleaning spray: Vital-Oxide. Professional cleaners will be in each week to deep-clean. The HVAC double filter has been replaced, and Medical Grade Filtration H13 True HEPA air purifiers have been installed throughout to provide the best air quality as possible. Each pod has their own inside room and own bathroom that will be maintained throughout the week. We will rotate our inside activities with outside activities for snack and lunch time.

Pick-up will be done one at a time and staggered similar to drop-off. Students will wait inside on their marker until their parent/guardian checks them out. Masks are required for pick up. Those picking up their camper must remain outside using designated signage/markers until it is their turn.
